Ice Fishing...

Our lake was mentioned in the Harald Palladium Newspaper as having very good Crappie fishing this winter. No wonder we were host to so many ice fisherman this season.

Lake management...

Professional Lake Management will begin their third year of water testing and weed control. All required notification pertaining to chemical treatment will be supplied to the residents in compliance with DEQ regulations. Enclosed in this mailing is the 2009 treatment schedule.

Phosphorous in fertilizer...

"In an effort toward improving and maintaining the county's lake and stream water quality, Van Buren County Commissioners unanimously approved an ordinance banning the use of phosphorus lawn fertilizer in the county." (Courier Leader, Jan. 16, 2009)

Fertilizer that does not contain phosphorous is readily available at local stores. Another source of unwanted phosphorous comes from ash that seeps into the lake from leaf burning areas and bon fire pits that are too near to the shoreline. They seep ash into the lake by way of rain run off. This problem can be lessened or eliminated by altering burning locations or removing the remaining ash from the area.

Phosphorous fertilizes the lake's weed population. Decreasing its entrance into the lake is the eco friendly way to control weed growth.

Marine Control Report for 2008 season...

Last year the marine patrol spent 15 hours patrolling Three Mile Lake. This resulted in 23 stops made by patrol, eleven warnings were given and one ticket issued. There were no accidents reported. Few complaints were called in from residents and this was a decline from previous years. Over the last several years the complaints were numerous and that was causing a greater patrol presence on our lake.

Most of the warnings that were given out were for violation of the 100 foot rule.

Please be safe this year and review the Three Mile Lake boating and fishing rules.
